



100 Club Rules

1. The subscription to the 100 Club for one number shall be £12 per year payable annually in advance. This will give members one number, which will be placed in 12 draws. Members may have as many numbers as they like.
2. Anybody over 16 may purchase a number and you are encouraged to get family and friends to join.
3. The 100 Club shall not be limited to 100 members. The more numbers we sell, the bigger the prizes.
4. There is no provision to opt in/out on a month-by-month basis. The 100 Club year will run from March to February. Members joining after the start of the normal 100 Club membership year will be charged a pro-rata amount for the rest of the year until February and entered in the next available draw following payment.
5. Numbers will be allocated by the 100 Club administrators on receipt of a completed registration form and payment.
6. There shall be one prize draw per month. The draw for each month will take place on the last Friday of the month. Draws taking place during school holidays will be done whenever practical.
7. 50% of the month's net payments shall make up the monthly prize. Initially there will be one prize per month. This will be reviewed and the number of prizes may change at the discretion of the 100 Club administrators, in order to reflect the success of the 100 Club.
8. The remaining 50% of the net payments will be allocated to the Friends of Altwood fundraising account.
9. Prize winners will be notified by email and the money will be sent by cheque to the home address of the member. The 100 Club administrators will make all reasonable efforts to post prizes to the winners within a reasonable period after the monthly draw.
10. Members wishing to leave the 100 Club should do so at the end of the club membership for that year. Refunds will not be given for people wishing to withdraw before the year end.
11. The decision of The Friends of Altwood Committee shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication.
12. The Friends of Altwood Committee shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club members as is necessary.
