Dear Families,

With our Sports Day set for Wednesday this week I just wanted to let you know that we will be watching the weather very carefully to make sure this event can continue in its original format.

Currently, the weather looks cloudy with highs of 23 degrees for Wednesday, which would be ideal for a sports day, but we have been making contingency plans and have several options if the weather is hotter on the day:

- We have already set up alternative activities for anyone who gets too hot, or feels unable to spectate in the afternoon, with Basketball available in the Sports Hall.

- Manned toilets and water stations have been set up to ensure pupils stay hydrated and can visit the toilets when needed.

- Stalls for students to purchase cold snacks / drinks, as well as the traditional House Face Painting have been organised.
