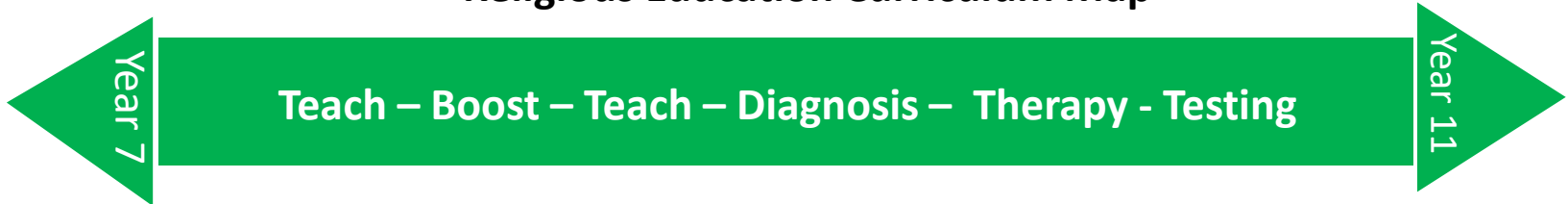
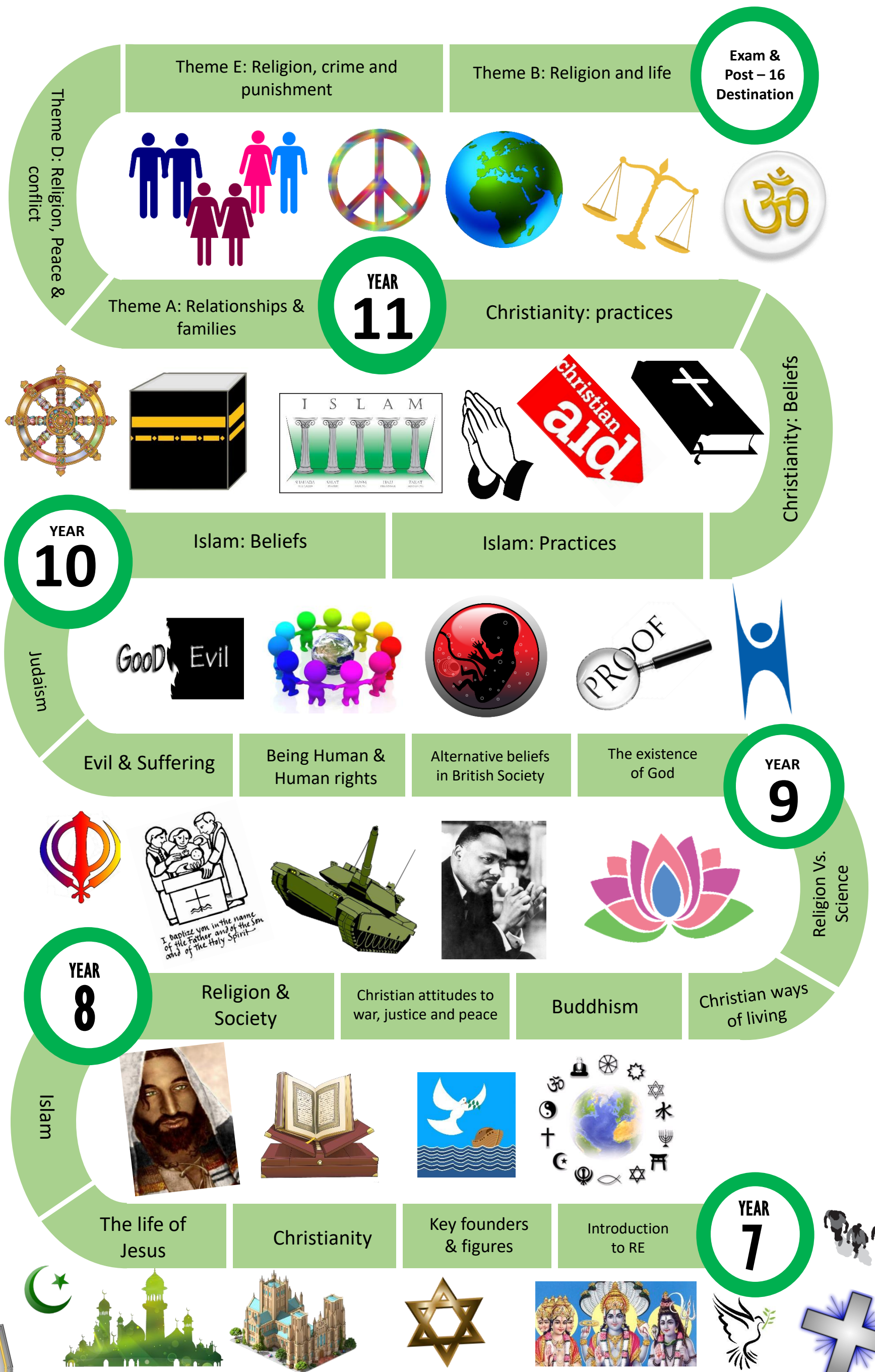


Religious Education Curriculum Map



In Religious Education, Altwood students will explore and challenge the beliefs of religious and non-religious people (including their own) and how these beliefs will influence their lives. We will equip students with the knowledge and skills to explore religious, ethical and philosophical issues within society, informed by the locally agreed syllabus (Pan-Berkshire scheme of work). The syllabus highlights the significance of learning the purpose, aims and importance of learning RE focussing on learning about and from religions and worldviews. The syllabus' eight key questions are explored throughout our curriculum (for Christianity) using a thematic and systematic approach and are addressed in other religious beliefs systems.
