The primary purpose of this role is to support teaching staff within the Art Department. Responsibilities will include preparing and organising materials for lessons, ensuring that health and safety regulations are consistently followed, undertaking administrative tasks, and maintaining a clean and safe working environment by caring for equipment and facilities. The role also involves monitoring stock levels and managing the ordering of departmental supplies.

The successful candidate will have daily contact with students therefore must have the ability to relate well to all young people.

Full training in health and safety procedures will also be provided to ensure safe working practices within the department and compliance with relevant regulations.
