



16 – 19 Tuition Fund Statement 2022 - 2023

The Government has introduced the 16 to 19 tuition fund. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19).

Our share of this funding is £4,170 for 2022-23

- The guidance related to the fund means that.
- Only learners who do not have grade 4 – 6 passes in either or both English and Maths GCSE at the end of KS4 can be supported by this fund.
- The Fund is not limited to supporting GCSE Maths and English but can be for any aim in the learner’s programme of study
- The need for support will be determined and agreed between the eligible learners and staff

Typically support will be in the form of small group tuition over and above the teaching timetabled for that subject.

GCSE English	Additional hours of small group tuition support from a qualified GCSE English teacher
GCSE Maths	Additional hours of small groups tuition from a qualified GCSE Maths teacher
Additional Tuition	Mentoring support for students to support progress CEIAG CPDL to upskill staff where necessary

The impact of these sessions will be monitored based on student performance and progress in their courses and their preparation for and confidence in applying to future destinations, including higher education, employment and apprenticeships.
