Every year in the Thames Valley, dozens of teenagers and young people are killed and seriously injured on our roads. "Safe Drive Stay Alive" is a theatre production designed to reduce the number of road traffic accidents. It involves Fire and Rescue, the NHS, South Central Ambulance Service, nine local authorities and Thames Valley Police, who have come together to produce a hard-hitting event watched by thousands of students.

We will be taking Year 12 and Year 13 students to the "Safe Drive Stay Alive" production on Wednesday 2nd November at The Hexagon Theatre, Reading. We will depart school by coach at 9:15am and return by 12:30pm.

The nominal cost of entry to the production has been covered by school and the cost of coach travel to and from the event has been covered by the Local Authority.

Please sign and return the permission slip below and ask your son/daughter to return it to myself by Thursday 21st October.

We believe that this opportunity will be a valuable learning experience for our senior students that may be a new driver, taking driving lessons or considering to in the near future.
