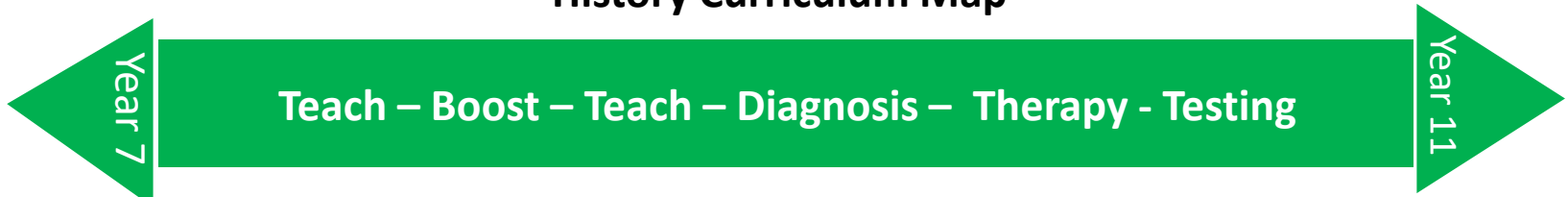


History Curriculum Map
