I am writing to share some important news with you.

Last week Neil Dimbleby was interviewed and offered the post of Headteacher at Lord Williams's School Thame to start 1st September 2024, which he has accepted. This will be Neil's second headship and will provide the opportunity for him to relocate.

Neil has been Headteacher at Altwood C of E School since September 2013. His leadership in this time has seen many changes and improvements at the school.
