Curriculum Overview - Year 11

The Big Picture:

Year 11 students will begin by returning to the 20th Century and a study of Conflict and Tension during the Inter-War Years. Terms 3, 4 and 5 will focus primarily upon revision of content with particular emphasis on how to tackle the wide range of GCSE question types.

AO1: demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the key features and characteristics of the period studied.

AO2: explain and analyse historical events and periods studied using second-order historical concepts.

AO3: analyse, evaluate and use sources (contemporary to the period) to make substantiated judgements, in the context of historical events studied.

AO4: analyse, evaluate and make substantiated judgements about interpretations (including how and why interpretations may differ) in the context of historical events studied.
