

Exam Certificate Third Party Collection Form



Certificates may be collected from school any time after the published collection date

Certificates are important legal documents – they are required for CVs, job applications and to verify the Statement of Results – and **should be collected from main reception in person**. Please keep them in a safe place. Uncollected certificates will be held in school for one year until the student arranges collection, but after that time any **uncollected certificates may be destroyed**. Exam boards will however provide a replacement certificate of results at a cost of approximately £43 per certificate.

If you are intending to collect your certificates yourself then no further action is necessary.

If you cannot collect them yourself then you can pay £10 to have them sent to you securely by the Royal Mail Signed For service (Option 1 - please see www.altwoodschool.co.uk/exams-information for details), or you can nominate someone else to collect them on your behalf (Option 2).

To use Option 2 please print off, complete and sign, and give this form to your representative who should bring it and their own photo ID when collecting your certificate(s).
